AAPSE is fully recognized by AAPCO as a participating member of full SFIREG and the AAPSE representative is frequently asked for AAPSE's opinion on subjects under discussion. It is vital that this relationship be continued because it is to the benefit of the Certification and Training Program to do so.

An ongoing theme during the past year at the meetings has been label language; mosquito control labeling, bee labeling, greenhouse labeling, unenforceable label language, mandatory vs. advisory label language, supplemental labels, and the Label Review Manual. SFIREG realizes that this is an area of interest to educators and it needs AAPSE's input – which they ask for and receive, i.e., what is needed is clear, unambiguous, enforceable language that we can teach.

AAPSE has had considerable input into the Section 25b issue, which is an ongoing issue and will remain so for a while.

Anytime outreach, training, or an educational program is discussed, AAPSE's input is asked for & listened to (I hope!)
