

AAPSE Life Membership

Life Membership is a special honor bestowed on those who have given their life's calling to pesticide safety education. Life members continue to serve the organization in this capacity and are entitled to receive publications, participate in regional and national meetings, hold office, serve as regional Board representatives, and serve on Association committees. Life members are exempt from payment of annual membership dues.

Eligibility and Nomination Process. Eligible nominees will have made outstanding contributions to AAPSE and pesticide safety education. Nominees cannot be serving on the AAPSE Executive Committee (EC).

Submission. Submit nomination letter as an email attachment to the AAPSE Secretary (bbuffing@iastate.edu) by the nomination deadline.

The nomination letter should be a brief synopsis providing an explanation of how the nominee made outstanding contributions to the work of AAPSE, including AAPSE service and achievement in education, certification, public service, research, personal achievement, and recognition. Letter not to exceed one page.

Evaluation. The AAPSE EC evaluates the nominations and selects Life Members on behalf of the Board of Directors.

Renomination. Any candidate nominated, but not selected, can be renominated with a revised nomination and updated support letters to the AAPSE Secretary by the nomination deadline.

Notification. The AAPSE President will notify all candidates and their nominators with the selection results.
